Minors must be submitted by the end of the student's FIFTH semester. IF THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS CHANGE OR A STUDENT WISHES TO VARY THE ABOVE-LISTED COURSES, A REVISED MINOR DECLARATION FORM SIGNED BY THE MINOR ADVISOR AND THE CHAIRPERSON MUST BE SUBMITTED.

When the following courses are completed satisfactorily, the minor field will be recorded on the student's academic record. A form must be submitted for EACH minor. **THE MINOR WILL NOT APPEAR ON THE DIPLOMA.**

REQUIREMENTS:

CHINESE: Any combination of Chinese language courses for a minimum of 16 credits.

FRENCH

16 credit hours are required above French 12 as follows:

1. French 143 (4)
2. 1 or 2 additional courses at the 100-200 level (4-8)
3. 1 or 2 courses at the 300 level (4-8) (These courses are open to students who have completed 8 credits of French beyond French 12)

GERMAN

16 credits above German 12 are required, including at least 1 course at the 300 level

JAPANESE

16 credits of Japanese (not including any MLL course).

RUSSIAN

16 credits of Russian (not including any MLL course).

SPANISH

16 credits are required above Spanish 12, as described for three minor tracks:

Spanish American Track. Spanish 141, 152, a 300-level course in Spanish American Literature, one course at the 200-level or above.

Peninsular Track. Spanish 141, 151, a 300-level course in Peninsular Literature, one course at the 200-level or above.

Professional Track. Spanish 141, 151 or 152, 211, one course at the 200-level or above.

For Chinese, Hebrew, and Latin American Studies, see appropriate areas studies

STUDY ABROAD

Students taking courses at a foreign university must consult their Associate Dean, the Registrar, the MLL Chair, and the advisor before leaving, to make sure that courses and credits earned abroad are transferable to Lehigh. Where applicable, Financial Aid must also be consulted. **A MAXIMUM OF 8 CREDITS MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THE MINOR.**

Advanced Placement and CEEB credits count towards graduation but NOT towards the minor.
